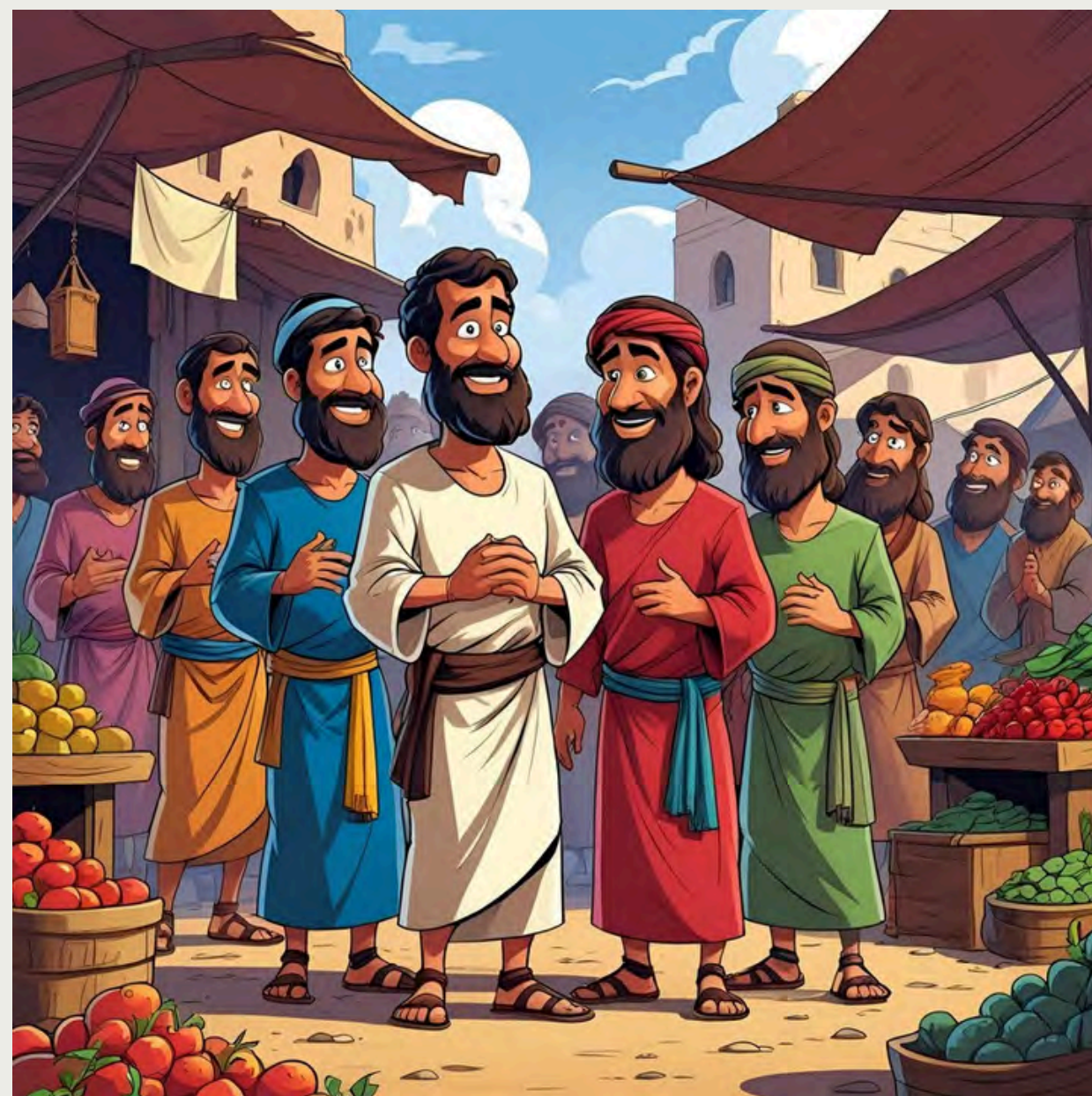

After this, Jesus traveled about from one town and village to another, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God. The Twelve were with him,² and also some women who had been cured of evil spirits and diseases: **Mary** (called Magdalene) from whom seven demons had come out;³ **Joanna** the wife of Chuza, the manager of Herod's household; **Susanna**; and **many others**. These women were helping to support them out of their own means.

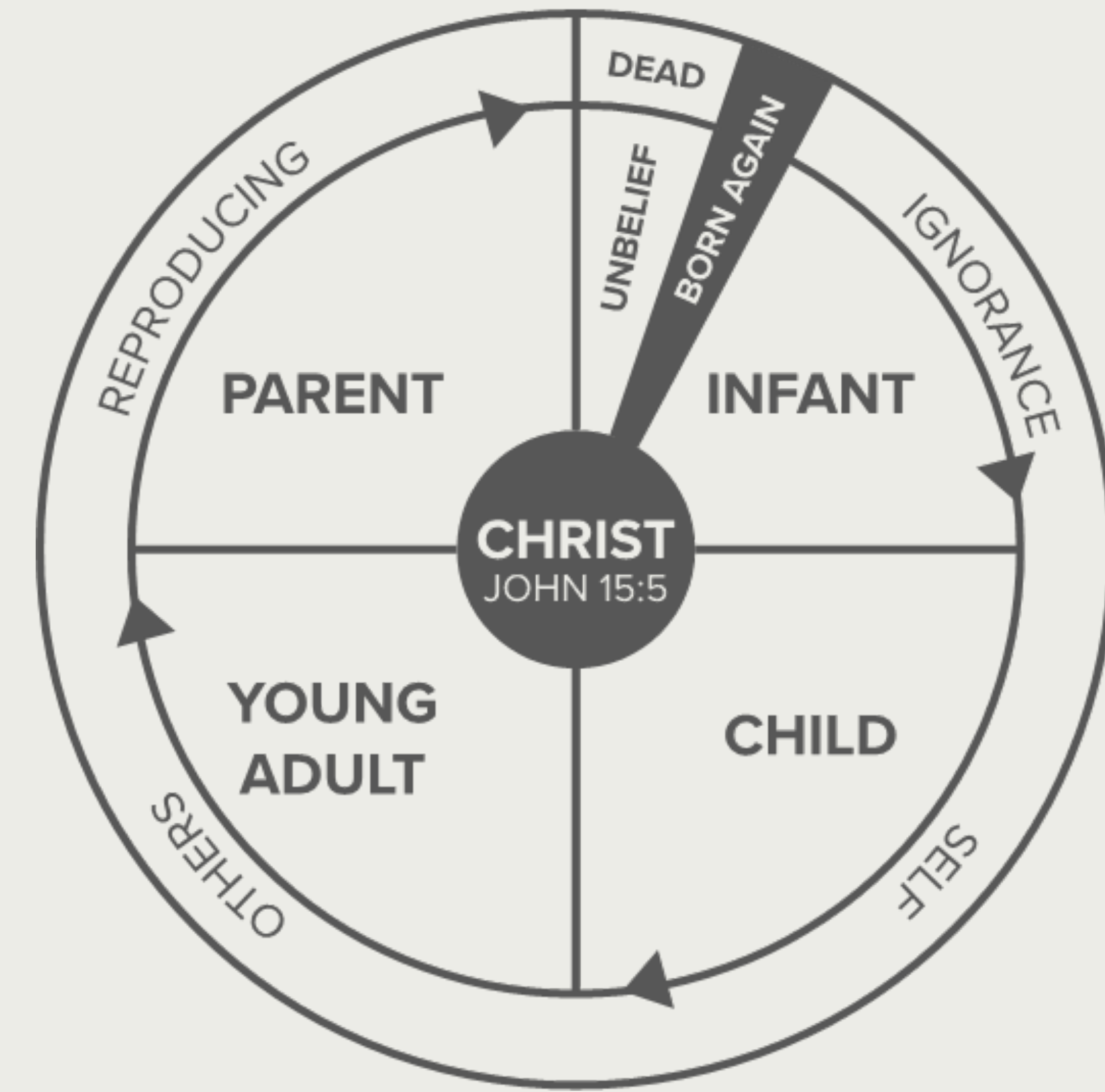
